

Everex gBook (VA1500V)

System recovery installation instructions

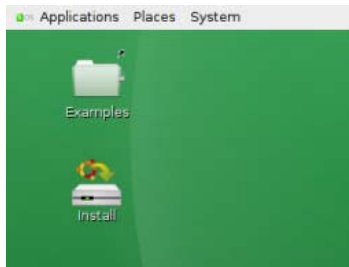
If you do not have the recovery disc. We recommend that you download the recovery image from the support site and burn the ISO image to a disc. The current file is roughly 800+ MBs, thus you will need a DVD-R or DVD-RW to burn the image onto.

Step 1: Disc insertion

- BootUp your gBook and wait until you see the Everex Logo screen. At this point you will need to press the **Pause/Break** key. This will pause the boot sequence to allow you to insert the recovery disc into the optical drive. Allow the system to boot off of the recovery disc as the system is preset to boot from the optical drive first.

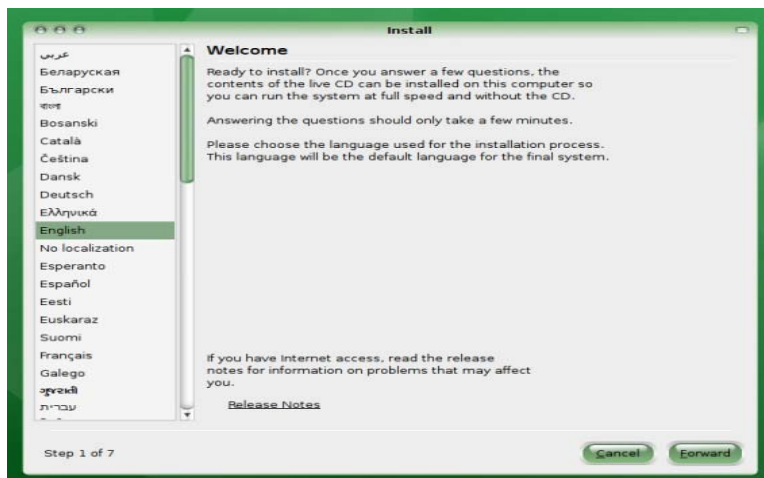
Step 2: Initiate install

- The system should boot the recovery disc and begin the installation of a virtual gOS. You will know this by the gOS logo. The first prompt will ask if you would like to **Start or install gOS**. At this point you will need to press the **ENTER** key. If not then the recovery process will auto continue within 30 seconds. There is a timer to let you know your remaining time to decide.
- Once the time has end or you selected ENTER. The gOS recovery process will continue to load a Virtual gOS into your system RAM. Please wait until the Virtual gOS loads.



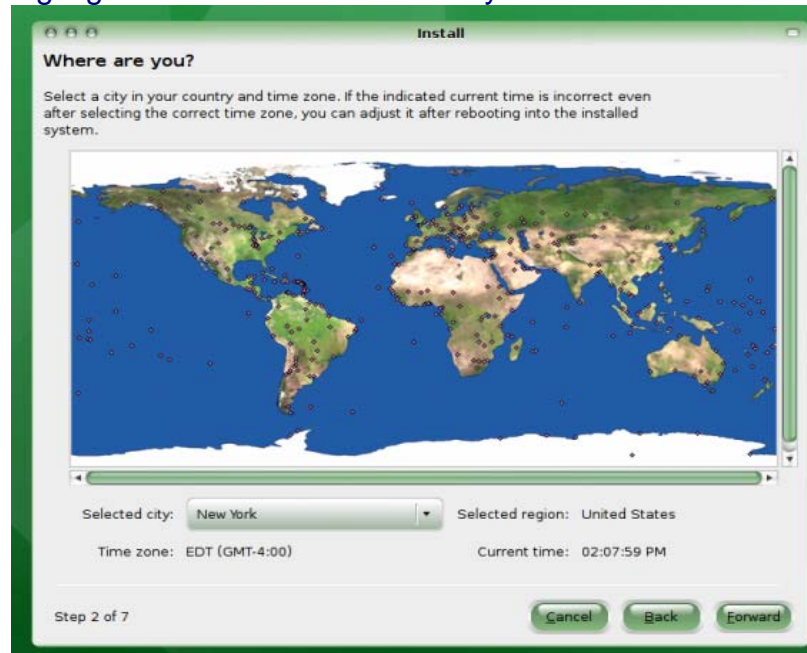
Step 3: Welcome

- Once you have reach the desktop of the Virtual gOS. You will notice on the top left corner an icon labeled **Install**. Please move the cursor over the icon and double click your left touchpad button. This will initiate the installation of the gOS recovery. A window will appear labeled **Install**. Please select the **Forward** button with the cursor and press the left touchpad button once.



Step 4: Where are you?

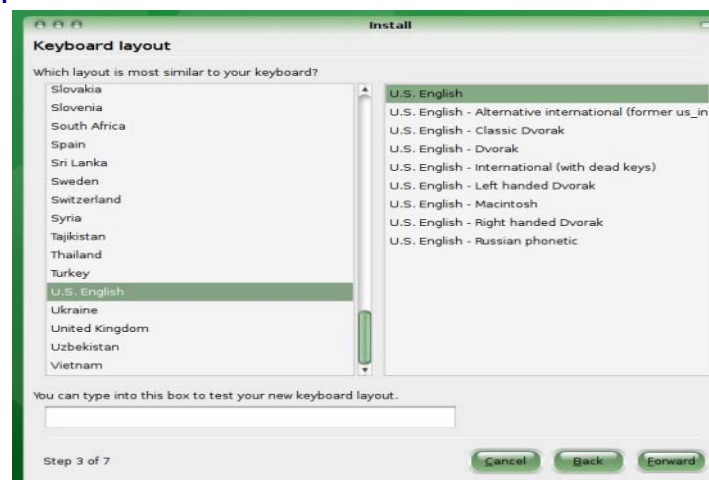
- The next page that appears is for setting the time zone.
- In this next page you need to select the city that is closest to your time zone.
- There are 2 ways to select the time zone.
 - **1st option:** Use the cursor and click the button next to where is states **Selected city**. A column will appear with a list of different cities around the world. Use the Page Up / Page Down keys to scroll up and down this column. You can use the cursor when you see your selected city.
 - **2nd option:** Use your cursor to zoom into the area close to where you are located on the map. Then highlight the dot that is closest to your location.



- Once you have selected your time zone. Click the **Forward** button to continue.

Step 5: Keyboard layout

- This next window is to verify your keyboard. The default should be U.S English in both windows. You can type in the lower box if you wish to test your keyboard.
- After you have verified the keyboard layout, please click the **Forward** button in the lower right corner to continue.



Step 6: Prepare disk space

- This next section relates to your hard disk drive usage. As we are recovering your system, please select the option **Guided – use entire disk**.
- Once you have selected, click the **Forward** button to continue.



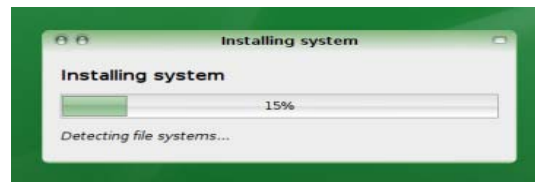
Step 7: Who are you?

- This next section relates to your user information.
 - Please enter your name in the first box. This information will be used to identify you in the system.
 - Please enter your username in the second box. By default your name is filled in. This information will be used to log you into the system.
 - Please enter your password in the following 2 boxes. Don't not cut and paste as your password may have been incorrectly entered.
 - Please enter the name for your gBook. This last box is for you to identify your gBook should it be connected to a network.
- Once you have completed all the entries, click the **Forward** button to continue.

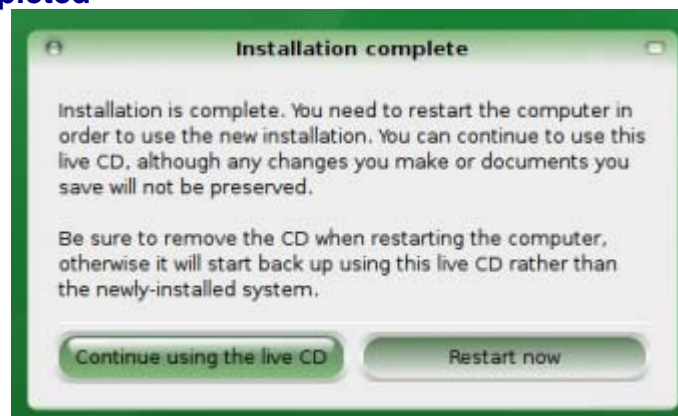


Step 8: Ready to install

- This next section relates to your overall system installation information.
- Please verify that all the related information that you entered is correct.
- Once you have reviewed, click the **Install** button to begin installation. This process should take roughly 30 minutes.



Step 9: Installation Completed



- Once the installation is complete, it will prompt you to continue with the Virtual gOS or restart now.
- Click on the **Restart now** button.
- Once the system restarts you may then press the eject button on the optical drive to remove the recovery disc. **Do not press eject until the system restarts as it needs the disk for the shutdown process. Should you have press eject, the system will stall on the reboot. You will then need to hold the power button down until the gBook shuts down. Then press the power button again to boot up normally.**
